<b>Topic/Subject of the workshop</b>	Stocking flower and bookmark making
<b>Objectives for conducting workshop</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ To introduce first-year students to the art of stocking flower and bookmark making.</li><li>▪ To enhance students' creative and artistic skills through hands-on practice.</li><li>▪ To emphasize the significance of these art forms, both as a potential career skill and as a creative outlet.</li><li>▪ To foster a sense of accomplishment, confidence, and efficiency among students..</li></ul>
<b>Methodology</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The two-day workshop on stocking flower and bookmark making aimed to provide hands-on experience and practical knowledge to the first-year students of St. Teresa's Institute of Education.</li><li>▪ The workshop was conducted through interactive sessions led by the resource persons, Ms. Harshita Sharma and Ms. Rachel D'Souza.</li><li>▪ The methodology involved a combination of demonstrations, step-by-step guidance, and student participation. Both sessions focused on a structured approach to learning, starting with an introduction to the art form and gradually progressing to creating the final products.</li></ul>
