
## CREATING TECH-SAVVY TEACHERS FOR FUTURE CLASSROOMS: 6th to 10th June, 2020



St. Teresa's Institute of Education in collaboration with EdFly Learn organized a 5-day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on "Creating Teach-Savvy Teachers for Future Classrooms" between 6th to 10th June, 2020. The webinar was streamed live on YouTube between 10:00 am to 11:00 am. The registration for the 5-day FDP was free and on attending all sessions and submitting he feedback form after every session, the participants would receive an E-certificate on their registered e-mail id.

On 6th June, which was the first day of the webinar, the session was inaugurated with an introduction of the college activities of St. Teresa's Institute of Education (STIE), followed by a prayer song. Thereafter, Dr. Sheela Philip, a faculty member of STIE, extended a warm welcome to the Resource Person, Dr. Sandhya Khedekar; the technical partners, Edfly Learn; the Lead Co-ordinator, Dr. Joan Lopes, the staff, students and all the delegates. Dr. Sr. Tanuja Waghmare, then spoke a few words cordially welcoming one and all, followed by a brief profile of the Resource Person. provided by Dr. Joan Lopes, the Lead Co-ordinator.

The live session was then taken over by Dr. Sandhya Khedekar, who discussed and elaborated on the educational tools that are helpful to teachers as well as learners. She began with a short introduction to the educational tools, followed by communicating the content for the day. She first demonstrated the use of Google Classroom and highlighted the various benefits of using Google Docs, followed by Google Forms and Google Sites. She then answered a few questions from the chat box. The session was then taken up by Ms. Manisha Thakur, the Founder of EdFly, who provided a brief introduction to EdFly Learn. Dr. Sheela Philip concluded the enlightening session for the first day.

On 7th June, the second day, the webinar began with a short welcome speech by Dr. Cerena D'Cunha, a faculty member of STIE. The webinar was then taken over by Dr. Sandhya Khedekar, who began with introducing the participants to Google Meet. Thereafter, she explained how to create web sites using Google Sites and the last topic for the day was Microsoft Teams, followed a question answer round. Ms. Manisha Thakur briefly spoke about the benefits of EdFly Learn and with that the session was brought to an end for the day.

On 8th June, the session began with a short prayer by Dr. Giselle D'souza, who called upon Dr. Sandhya Khedekar, who shared ways of making videos of online lectures by illustrating the different ways in which videos can be recorded. She also threw light on creating

YouTube channel with demonstration. She then addressed the questions from the chat box. The session was taken over by Ms. Manisha Thakur who elaborated on the features of EdFly Learn, with that the session was wrapped up for the day.

On 9th June, the fouth day of the webinar, the live streaming commenced with a prayer by Dr. Cindrella D'mello, who welcomed the participants for the day. The session was taken over by Dr. Sandhya Khedekar, who demonstrated the creation of a PPT with voiceover. She then illustrated the use of the site blackboard.fi, followed by illustrating the ways in which teachers can make use of classroomscreen.com, physically or virtually. the session was then taken over by Ms. Manisha Thakur, who spent a few minutes talking about EdFly Learn and with that she ended the session for the day.

On 10th June, the last day of the webinar, the live streaming began with welcoming all participants to the last day, followed by a prayer song on teachers. The session was taken over by Dr. Sandhya Khedekar, who discussed a list of digital assessment tools that are of great help to teachers. At the end of her session, there was a short feedback session which included the feedback from two participants – Ms Gloria. A. Raju and Ms Nina Narasimhan. Therafter, Dr. Agnes D'Costa, Asso. Prof. Pushpanjali College of Education, was called upon for the valedictory address. Towards the end of the session, Dr. Reshma Rodrigues, Faculty Member of STIE, proposed a vote of thanks. The webinar was concluded with Dr. Sandhya Khedekar addressing all participants, leaving them with a loads of educational tools to explore and enabling them to become "Tech-Savvy Teachers for Future Classrooms".
