<b>Topic/Subject of the Activity</b>	English Poetry Recitation Competition
<b>Objectives for conducting Activity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To build self-confidence, develop oratory skills and self-expression.</li><li>• To enjoy and appreciate the poem by reciting it aloud.</li><li>• To develop aesthetic sense, generate self-confidence and develop the power of imagination among students.</li></ul>
<b>Methodology</b>	Students were encouraged to recite their own poems as well as poems written by other authors. Poems had to be recited by memorizing them. The best three recitations were awarded.
<b>Outcome</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The competition inspired the poets to come forward and recite on stage. Students appreciated the poems and were encouraged to produce literary work of their own.</li><li>• Students developed self-confidence and trained themselves in reciting the poems with correct dictions, intonation, rhythm etc.</li><li>• This activity encouraged and enhanced critical thinking, creative thinking and helped in organising thoughts and improving communication skills.</li></ul>
