Action Taken Report of Practice Teaching Schools Feedback Analysis

- ➤ Since, some of the student teachers hailed from vernacular backgrounds it can be observed that their proficiency in spoken English needed attention. It was with this view in focus that the college conducted the English Grammar course to improve their proficiency in grammatically correct sentence construction and conversational skills.
- ➤ To boost their technological knowhow and skills they were enrolled for the Tech Fluent Teachers' Certificate Course conceptualised and conducted by the college which helped them to excel at their virtual teaching making their lessons innovative, interactive and interesting.
- ➤ To enhance their content knowledge, the Content Enrichment Programme was launched to improve their mastery of concepts related to their subjects of specialisation before they could commence practice-teaching.
- > To help them build their proficiency, creativity and innovativeness skill based assignments and the Big Five Talk Show have been introduced by the college to train student teachers in pedagogical knowledge and skills making them well equipped and proficient to teach in schools affiliated to the different boards of education.
- ➤ To step up their organisational skills they are provided with opportunities for organising and conducting several co-curricular activities to pep up their confidence, planning and entrepreneurship skills.
