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MINUTES OF THE CDC MEETING HELD ON 25TH MARCH 2019

The meeting commenced with a short prayer. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Principal Dr. Sr. Tanuja Waghmare, proposed by Dr. Giselle D'souza and seconded by Dr. Sheela Philip.

Dr. Sr. Tanuja informed the members about the voluntary resignation of Mrs. Medha Lotlikar from the committee on grounds that she did not qualify as an alumnus of the Institution having opted for the college only as a contact centre for her M.Ed degree. It was then decided that the Management would have to appoint one member on the committee being from the field of Social Service.

The faculty members presented a brief overview of curricular and co-curricular activities conducted in the period ranging from December 2018 to March 2019. Mr. Francis Athaide expressed his appreciation for the work done and the prizes won by students at several intercollegiate competitions.

Sr. Tanuja updated the members about the developments regarding the absenteeism issue of First Year B.Ed student Ms. Aditi Gadre that had been raised at the earlier CDC meeting. The college had taken the recommendations of the CDC members and sent a number of warning letters to the student's residence informing her of the repercussions of her continued absence from college, stating that she was liable to being withheld from appearing at the University Examination. Dr. Joan Lopes and Ms. Colleen Fernandes had personally visited her residence to inform her parents about her behaviour, which was cause for concern. Dr. Sheela Philip had offered her constructive advice and helped her make a well-informed choice about whether she wanted to pursue the course or opt out. Finally, after repeated efforts the student opted out of the course voluntarily. Mr.Francis Athaide reiterated that this was to the advantage of the college as there was no scope for unpleasantness on either side.

Dr. Sr. Tanuja also mentioned that the Self-financed Course, which was to be conducted by alumnus Claudette Lobo at St. Teresa's Institute of Education campus, did not meet with approval due to the extended timings which would pose security issues. The same was to be reconsidered if adjustments were possible. Sr. Tanuja thanked the members for their presence and contribution to the growth of the institution. The meeting ended with a prayer.

MINUTES OF THE CDC MEETING HELD ON 23rd APRIL 2019.

The meeting commenced with a short prayer. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by Principal Dr. Sr. Tanuja Waghmare, proposed by Dr. Joan Lopes and seconded by Dr. Giselle D'souza.

The faculty members presented a brief overview of curricular and co-curricular activities conducted in the period ranging from December 2018 to April 2019. Discussion started about the viability of the B.Ed. course. Mr. Francis Athaide asked whether the Indian B.Ed. degree is accepted in the foreign countries. Discussion ensued which concluded that qualifying exams etc. help students to get absorbed in the foreign countries. Mr. Francis Athaide suggested that the syllabus of qualifying exams could be used to train our students in order to better equip them for such exams.

Dr. Sr. Tanuja Waghmare spoke about the four year integrated B.Ed. course which is planned to be introduced. Dr. Indu Garg mentioned that the objective of such course with increased duration is to ensure the improvement in the quality of teachers. Further she mentioned that the objective of the B.Ed. course by IGNOU was to enable working teachers to get a B.Ed. degree.

Dr. Sr. Tanuja Waghmare mentioned that St. Teresa's Institute of Education wants to start a B.Ed. – M.Ed. integrated course. It was discussed further and Dr. Indu Garg and other teachers emphasized that with many private colleges closing down their M.Ed. section due to less enrollment of students, the future of such a course appears to be bleak.

Dr. Garg suggested to plan activities and courses which will help the college to stand out. This was seconded by Mr. Francis Athaide. Further Dr. Garg suggested to have training for student-teachers to equip themselves for teaching in CBSE, ICSE and IB board schools. With regards to this Dr. Sheela Philip mentioned that we intend to send our student-teachers to different board schools for internship, but there are many hurdles like content mastery of the student-teachers and gaps in knowledge.

Dr. Indu Garg said that it is necessary to update students' knowledge to be able to teach in current times. In relation to this it was mentioned that Dr. Cerena D'Cunha would be starting with a Grammar Course from next academic year in order to improve student-teacher's English language skills. Dr. Garg further said that the college must have classes for content enrichment too and the college could invite school teachers and alumni for the purpose.

The meeting ended with serving of snacks and a vote of thanks.
