An Online Meeting of the College Development Committee was held on Tuesday 5th August 2023 at 10.30 a.m.

The Following members of the CDC were present for the meeting: Manager Sr. Louella Rodrigues, Sr. Dr. Sunayana Kadle, Dr. Pradnya Wakpainjan, Sr. Tanuja Waghmare, In-Charge Principal Dr. Giselle D'Souza, and all the Staff members viz., Dr. Joan Lopes, Dr. Cindrella D'Mello, Dr. Cerena D'Cunha, Dr. Reshma Rodrigues, Dr. Shakuntala Nighot, Mrs. Sharmila Vaz, Mrs. Colleen Fernandes.

Dr. Giselle D'Souza, the In-charge Principal of St. Teresa's Institute of Education welcomed all the committee members and began the meeting with a prayer. Thereafter Sr. Tanuja Waghmare introduced Dr. Giselle D'Souza as the In-Charge Principal to the

committee members and also welcomed Sr. Louella Rodrigues and introduced her as the new Manager. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Principal, which were approved and proposed by Dr. Cindrella D'Mello and seconded by Dr. Joan Lopes.

The activities undertaken by the college were presented by Dr. Cerena D'Cunha and the roles played by the earlier CDC committees were substantiated. Thereafter, Dr. Cindrella D'Mello began the presentation highlighting the work done and milestones crossed for the upcoming NAAC visit. Dr. Cerena D'Cunha presented the college inputs for NAAC Criterion 1. After which suggestions were requested for improvement in the presentation for NAAC Peer Team visit. Dr. Pradnya Wakpainjan suggested to upload the Filled-in Sample forms of the feedback obtained from the stakeholders and ensure that the curriculum shows adherence with NAAC values.

Dr. Reshma Rodrigues presented Criterion 2 highlighting the work done in the criteria. Dr. Pradnya Wakpainjan suggested that samples of mapping could be uploaded in relation to Bloom's Taxonomy and flexibility should be given in assignments to cater to student needs. Assignments could be segregated into 3 levels and appropriate choice as per the students' ability could be made available. Dr. Sunaina Kadle inquired about the differentiated assessment made available to the students. Dr Reshma Rodrigues justified that choice of assignments is given and in certain situations, need-based alteration or modification of assessment is done and different assessment tools are used.

Criterion 3 was presented by Dr. Cindrella D'Mello underlining the finer points mentioned in the SSR regarding this criteria. Dr. Sunaina Kadle discussed about the feasibility of faculty and student exchange programmes. The Manager Sr. Louella Rodrigues suggested that Alumni Committee could come up with the Golden Jubilee Magazine. Dr. Pradnya Wakpainjain suggested that the staff should send proposals to ICSSR for Minor and Major Research and suggested that proposals sent during the 5 year period could be documented and shown to the Peer Team in their visit even if they had not been approved. Dr. Wakpainjain and Dr. Kadle suggested to maintain the Registered Alumni as it is an added credit to the institution and to record all the Alumni Association activities and involvement in a file. Dr. Kadle suggested that Research Centre should be started and thereafter the staff should apply for being Research Guides. Sr. Louella suggested that stakeholders and faculty should be involved to raise funds. Dr. Wakpainjain inquired whether a Research Policy is in place and she was informed that the college has one.

Work reported in Criterion 4 of SSR was elaborated by Librarian Dr. Shakuntala Nighot. Dr. Wakpainjain suggested that a Best Library User Award should be announced per month for students, faculty and support staff. She also proposed that Dr. Nighot could keep teachers informed about the processes, undertakings and innovative activities of the library. Post the name of the Best Library User awardee and the brochures etc. on Facebook account of the college.

Criterion 5 was expounded by Dr. Joan Lopes and it was suggested that activities of relevance like Azadi ka Amrit Mohotsav; could be added to the ppt to enrich the presentation. Thereafter Criterion 6 was presented by Dr. Cindrella D'Mello. Dr. Wakpainjain advised to mention in the ppt the health related initiatives like physical check-up drives or sessions undertaken by the college. It was also suggested that Academic Administrative Audit should be done every year and to preserve the documentation.

Work done in Criterion 7 was presented by Dr. Giselle D'Souza. In this criterion it was suggested that NGO's who had partnered with the institution for the Green Initiatives undertaken by the college, and all Environmental Audits conducted should be portrayed in the presentation. She appreciated the Tree Landscaping Endeavour carried out by the college.

It was also suggested that hard copies of the documentation should be kept ready for the Peer Team perusal during the visit. The Grievance Redressal Records should be maintained and kept ready. Dr. Cerena D'Cunha explained the Grievance Redressal Mechanism at St. Teresa's Institute of Education.

Subsequently an informal discussion ensued with the Committee members in which various other matters were discussed regarding benefits and betterment of the college.

Dr. Giselle D'Souza thanked all the Committee members for their valuable time and fruitful suggestions and the meeting ended on a happy note with a promise to continue the good work.
