Eligibility and Admission

Eligibility :

Following candidates are eligible for admission:

a) Candidates with at least 50 % marks either in the Bachelor Degree(three year programme) in B.A, B.Sc or 50% (49.50-49.99%) in post graduation and for the reserved category (ST,SC,OBC,VJNT 1,2,3) 45% (44.50-44.99%) will be eligible. For B.Com, Management, Engineering, Computer Science, Technology, Agriculture, BBI, Pharmacy, Law, Fine Arts Performing Arts, Music, Dance, Drama with 55% marks at graduation or post graduation will be eligible for open category and for reserved category 50%. Any other qualification equivalent thereof is eligible for admission to the programme. b) The reservation and relaxation for SC/ ST / OBC / PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government, whichever is applicable

Admission procedure

Those seeking admission to the Two Year B.Ed Course have to pass the B.Ed CET(Common Entrance Test) and ELCT(English Language Content Test) conducted by State Common Entrance Test Cell, Government of Maharashtra. Details are available on <https://cetcell.mahacet.org/>

Fees will be as per the University (Maharashtra Govt.) directives from time to time. The fee is subject to change as per the govt. directives from time to time.
